

Puppy Visit Guidelines

Taking care of parent dogs and puppies can be a 24/7 job. There is pretty much always something we will be busy with such as cleaning, feeding, vet trips, construction work, supply runs, communicating with clients, paperwork, socializing the puppies, exercising the dogs and much MUCH more.

Because we want to give them the best care possible and give you the best experience possible, we ask that you please follow these guidelines.

- **Please be as close to the appointment time as possible.**
 - If you do not have an exact appointment time, we do require that you make one. This is to help everyone's experience run smoothly.

- **If you are more than an hour late for an appointment, we will need to reschedule with you.**
 - If you think you will be a little early or a little late, that will be fine but anymore than 45 minutes of delay can really jumble our schedule. - **Please do not visit any pet stores/ dog parks/ or other breeders before visiting us.**
 - Our puppies get their first vaccination at 5 weeks old and their 2nd at 8 weeks old. They will eventually need a total of 4 shots before they are completely protected against things like parvovirus. Since they will not be completely protected yet, we kindly ask that you help minimize the risk of contagious pathogens to our kennel as much as possible and not visit any areas where there could be unvaccinated animals.

- **Please do not bring any other pets with you.**
 - Although we would love to visit with your pet, it is by our vet's recommendation that we do not allow outside dogs onto the property. This rule is to protect our young ones that are still not fully vaccinated and susceptible to outside contamination.

- **Puppy Pick-outs are limited to an hour.**
 - We would love to give you and your family all the time in the world but as stated above, we can be extremely busy. We will be there to answer any questions you might have about the litter's appearance, personality, and nature to help you and your family make a selection you feel pleased with.

- **Do not hesitate to ask questions!**

- You may even like to bring a notepad with you to jot down notes to help you prepare for your future family member. Pictures are allowed and encouraged as well!
